NOTICE OF THE 2024 ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the 2024 annual general meeting (the “**AGM**”) of Guangdong Join-Share Financing Guarantee Investment Co., Ltd.* (廣東中盈盛達融資擔保投資股份有限公司) (the “**Company**”, together with its subsidiaries, the “**Group**”) will be held at the Training Room, 40th Floor, Block 1, Join-Share International Financing Center, No. 31 Fuhua Road, Dongping Community, Lecong Town, Shunde District, Foshan, Guangdong Province, the People's Republic of China (the “**PRC**”) on Friday, 6 June 2025 at 3:00 p.m., for the purpose of considering and, if thought fit, passing the following resolutions:

ORDINARY RESOLUTIONS

1. To consider and approve the report of the board (the “**Board**”) of directors (the “**Director(s)**”) of the Company for the year ended 31 December 2024 as set out in the annual report of the Company dated 27 March 2025 (the “**Annual Report**”);
2. To consider and approve the report of the board of supervisors of the Company for the year ended 31 December 2024 as set out in the Annual Report;
3. To consider and approve the audited financial statements and the independent auditor's report of the Company for the year ended 31 December 2024 as set out in the Annual Report;
4. To consider and approve the dividend distribution plan for the year ended 31 December 2024 as set out in the Annual Report;

5. To consider and approve the budget plan of the Group for the year ending 31 December 2025. To meet the Group's strategic development and business operation plans, the Company has budgeted operating expenses of RMB294.9 million for the year ending 31 December 2025, with an aim to steadily improve revenue and further control risks, the breakdown of which is set out as follows:
- (i) approximately RMB86.75 million will be used to pay the labor costs of the Group;
 - (ii) approximately RMB38.45 million will be used to pay the operating expenses of the Group;
 - (iii) approximately RMB10.0 million will be used to pay the expenses incurred from the operation of the Board, the board of supervisors and the general meeting of the Company, the maintenance expenses of the Group after listing and after issuance of bonds, and the expenses incurred from the restructuring of the Group;
 - (iv) approximately RMB36.6 million will be used for the payment of interest and guarantee fees for the issuance of bonds, and the financing costs of the Group's micro-lending business, factoring business and supply chain business;
 - (v) approximately RMB2.5 million will be used to pay value-added tax and surtax of the Group;
 - (vi) approximately RMB119.6 million will be used for the various accrued risk reserves of the Group; and
 - (vii) approximately RMB1.0 million will be used to pay the financial expenses and others of the Group.
6. To consider and approve the reappointment of KPMG as the Company's auditor and to authorise the Board to fix its remuneration for the year ending 31 December 2025.

Notes:

1. In order to determine the shareholders' eligibility to attend the AGM, the register of members of the Company will be closed from Tuesday, 3 June 2025 to Friday, 6 June 2025, both days inclusive, during which no transfer of shares will be registered. Only shareholders of the Company (the "**Shareholders**") whose names appear on the register of members of the Company on Friday, 6 June 2025 or their proxies or duly authorised corporate representatives are entitled to attend the AGM. In order to qualify for attending and voting at the AGM, all properly completed transfer documents accompanied with relevant share certificates must be lodged with the Company's H share registrar, Computershare Hong Kong Investor Services Limited at Shops 1712–1716, 17th Floor, Hopewell Centre, 183 Queen's Road East, Wanchai, Hong Kong (for holders of H shares), or the Company's office in the PRC at Room 4101–4110, Block 1, Join-Share International Financing Center, No. 31 Fuhua Road, Dongping Community, Lecong Town, Shunde District, Foshan, Guangdong Province, the PRC (for holders of domestic shares) not later than 4:30 p.m. on Monday, 2 June 2025.
2. A Shareholder entitled to attend and vote at the AGM may appoint one or more person (whether he/she is a Shareholder or not) to attend and vote at the same on his or her behalf.
3. The instrument appointing a proxy must be in writing and signed by a Shareholder or his duly authorised attorney. If the Shareholder is a corporation, such instrument must be either under its common seal or duly signed by its legal representative, director(s) or duly authorised attorney(s).
4. Shareholders who intend to attend the AGM by proxy should complete the proxy form. For holders of H shares, the proxy form should be returned to Computershare Hong Kong Investor Services Limited at 17M Floor, Hopewell Centre, 183 Queen's Road East, Wanchai, Hong Kong and for holders of domestic shares, the proxy form should be returned to the Company's office in the PRC at Room 4101–4110, Block 1, Join-Share International Financing Center, No. 31 Fuhua Road, Dongping Community, Lecong Town, Shunde District, Foshan, Guangdong Province, the PRC, in person or by post not later than 24 hours before the time appointed for holding of the AGM or any adjournment thereof. Completion and return of the proxy form will not preclude you from attending thereof and voting in person at the AGM or any adjournment thereof.
5. Shareholders or their proxies shall provide their identity documents when attending the AGM.
6. The AGM is expected to last for less than half a day. Shareholders (in person or by proxy) attending the AGM are responsible for their own transportation and accommodation expenses. Shareholders or their proxies attending the AGM shall present their identity certifications.
7. The register of members of the Company will be closed from Thursday, 12 June 2025 to Tuesday, 17 June 2025, both days inclusive, for the purposes of determining Shareholders' entitlements to the proposed final dividend, during which period no transfer of shares of the Company will be registered. Shareholders whose names appear on the register of members of the Company on Tuesday, 17 June 2025 are entitled to the proposed final dividend. In order to ascertain Shareholders' entitlement to the proposed final dividend, all properly completed transfer documents accompanied with the relevant share certificates must be lodged with the Company's H share registrar, Computershare Hong Kong Investor Services Limited, at Shops 1712–1716, 17th Floor, Hopewell Centre, 183 Queen's Road East, Wanchai, Hong Kong (for holders of H shares), or the Company's office in the PRC at Room 4101–4110, Block 1, Join-Share International Financing Center, No. 31 Fuhua Road, Dongping Community, Lecong Town, Shunde District, Foshan, Guangdong Province, the PRC (for holders of domestic shares) for registration not later than 4:30 p.m. on Wednesday, 11 June 2025.
